WHAT IS Building Twentyone?

At Building Twentyone, we don't just run programs — we shape pathways for students to thrive. Our approach is grounded in the principles of Positive Youth Development, a proven framework that nurtures the whole person — socially, emotionally, spiritually, physically and intellectually.

Focus 30

Teen Advisory Council

At B21 we have the Teen Advisory Council (TAC). It meets regularly, and it gives eligible high school students the agency to plan, organize, and implement programs and events. Students develop life-changing leadership skills when given the responsibility to create a fun and safe environment for their peers.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is membership and how much does it cost?

Is transportation included in my membership?

We provide transportation to our facility from the Holt Junior High and Holt High School for our after school open space on Monday's, Tuesday's, and Thursday's. Do I need to register each of my students individually within my portal?

Yes. This will create a profile for each of your students making sign up for our core enrichment programs easier.

Does my students membership expire?

Each membership is good for the duration of the current school year for which you registered. It expires on the last open day of the school year.

What is the cancellation policy for program attendance?

We value and respect our facilitators' time and effort. When you register for a program, please be consistent and attend. If your plans change, please notify B21 of your cancellation within 48 hours of your scheduled program. If you fail to notify us within 48 hours, it can affect your eligibility for future programs.
